Students Requirements:

*Fine tipped soldering iron if you have one

*Glass cutting plate

Fine grade wire wool

Small terracotta pot – to stand soldering iron in

Any templates you may have to cut around – flat metal template is the best

Extension lead

Basic sewing kit including scissors

*If you do not have either of these items Christine can provide them for the workshop, let me know if you require them for use at the workshop.

If you have any synthetic fabric at home bring them along to use at the workshop.
