Light Molding Paste can be used in a variety of ways for surface decoration and it will still remain easy to stitch into. Isobel has been working & experimenting with Light Molding Paste for the last two years and is now eager to show case this remarkable material and illustrate its great potential.

During the two day workshop you will learn ways of working with the Molding Paste. You will explore the potential on this exciting workshop in addition to learning how to create Isobel's unique technique for making and working on what she calls "molding paste fabric". The resulting fabric will be suitable for book covers, bag decoration, jewellery and vessels.

ISOBEL HALL “Molding Paste Fabric”

Student Requirements for the Workshop:

Vaseline

Paint brushes

Plastic Glue Spreader

Rubber Spatula

Baby Wipes

Kitchen Towel

Cheap Icing tube & Nozzle

*Rubber Stamps, *Texture Mat & *Stencils

Embossing powders – if you do not have any we will have some available to use at the workshop

Sandpaper

Baking Parchment & Teflon Mat

Plastic Apron

Thin paper such as tissue, teabag paper (Isobel will have this at the workshop for you to purchase), book binders tissue.

You will need to bring **either** fabric or paper and it could be whatever you have to hand but it must be able to be coloured with paints. Plain fabric is a better option as patterned fabric will need to be knocked back with gesso. The amount of fabric you will need to bring will depend upon what you want to make at the workshop but a minimum piece approx size of 30cms
Suggested Fabric – plain furnishing fabric, light weight Vilene, calico, cotton

Paper:

Two x A4 size or one x A3 size in your choice of paper

Suggested Paper– this could be kozo paper, cocoon stripping paper, silk paper

*Isobel will have a selection of stamps, stencils & texture mats to use at the workshop but if you have any of your own that you would like to bring along, please do.
