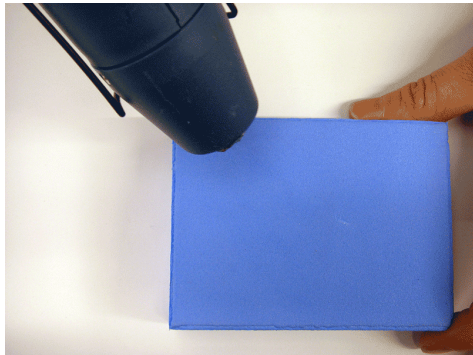


MAGIC STAMP

“Magic stamp” is a heat mouldable foam that can be used to create re-useable stamps



Heat the surface of the “Magic Stamp” with a heat gun, until the surface changes from matte to a slightly shimmery effect. The stamp is now ready to accept the design.



Use elastic bands, paper clips, safety pins, string, raised patterned surfaces, etc as ‘textures’ for imprinting. The foam of the “Magic Stamp” cools down very quickly, therefore to get a good imprint you need to have your ‘textures’ ready on a firm surface and push the magic stamp onto them as soon as the surface is warm enough. [See above]



Use ink pads, acrylic paint, fabric & textile paints, etc to colour up the “magic stamp” for printing. Make sure that you place the stamp onto a firm surface to apply the ink or paint evenly



You can print onto paper fabric, card, etc.



Remove the ink/paint from the surface of the stamp with alcohol free baby wipes.

The “magic stamp” will maintain the original impression until you re-heat it with the heat gun and the surface will become flat again and is ready to re-use.

The “magic stamp” can be re-used numerous times.
